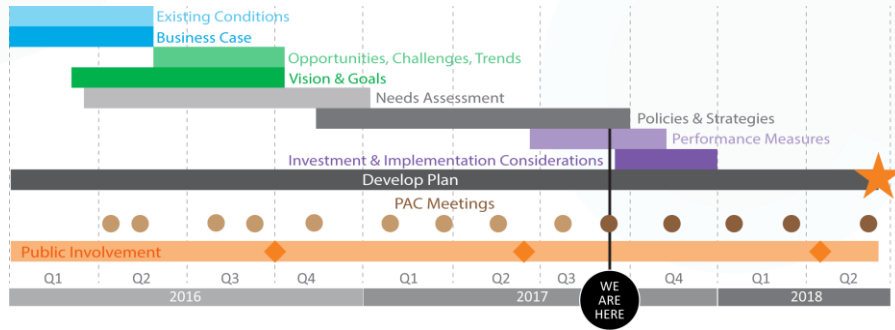

Stakeholder Feedback

- Comprehensive information available statewide
- Safe stops, safe access to stops: first/last mile
- Regional and intercity connectivity
- Easy connections / transfers
- Fare affordability
- Provide educational resources
- Strategic coordination and partnerships
- Develop transit-supportive incentives
- Consider emerging transportation options for services



Themes in Implementation Ideas

Three implementation themes are:

- **Technology:** use of new technologies in or with transit
- **Mobility Management:** techniques to use system efficiently
- **Regional and Intercity:** service between places

- These are not all implementation ideas
- They carry across multiple OPTP goals



Goals, Policies Reflected in Implementation Ideas

- **Goal 1: Mobility: Public Transportation User Experience**
- **Goal 2: Accessibility and Connectivity: Getting from Here to There**
- **Goal 6: Safety and Security**
- **Goal 9: Strategic Investment**
- **Goal 10: Communication, Coordination, and Collaboration**



Implementation Themes Feedback

- **Technology**
 - One stop information options, in multiple formats
 - Efare and shared efare, payment systems
 - Enabling systems to work together
 - Partnerships with technology companies and TNCs
- **Mobility Management**
 - Increase ridership and transit efficiency
 - Increase transit familiarity through outreach
 - Explore sharing some services
 - Better link with transportation options
- **Regional and Intercity**
 - Facilitate connections between providers
 - Define important routes with no or insufficient service
 - Promote development of mobility hubs
